

BGvACC Euroscope Update Guide

This is a guide on how to update your sectorfiles each time a new update is released. Please follow the steps below carefully. At the bottom, there is a list of the most common items that you will need to fill in again/set up after the update is complete.




As of right now, an update package is NOT available, so this guide assumes that you are downloading and updating ALL files.

How to update your Euroscope sectorfiles

1. Download the new sectorfile package from the AeroNav link and extract it somewhere easily accessible. Do not move the files anywhere yet, we will get back to them in a later step.
2. Navigate to the folder where the current sectorfile is located. This will usually be the **Euroscope** folder within AppData:

C:\Users\yourusername\AppData\Roaming\EuroScope

3. In this folder, locate and **DELETE** the following three files:

These are the old sectorfiles and are no longer needed if you are updating.

4. Now, drag and drop **all** of the files you downloaded in step 1 (**the new sectorfile package**) into the same folder as your old files. Again, this should be the main Euroscope folder in AppData.

Replace all files with the same name. This will overwrite the old files and update them.

5. Your sectorfiles have now been updated. You can open Euroscope and set up your login and custom settings again.

Required data setup when downloading or updating your sectorfiles

- Fill in your login information on the Connection page (Name, CID, password, rating)
- Fill in your VCCS username (VATSIM CID) on the VCCS setup page
- **[TopSky only]** Paste your CPDLC Hoppie code in the file:

~\EuroScope\LBSR\Plugins\TopSky\TopSkyCPDLCChoppieCode

- **[Optional]** Custom colour customizations can be found in the following files:

~\EuroScope\LBSR\Plugins\TopSky\TopSkyMaps (for TopSky)

~\EuroScope\LBSR\SATCASBulgaria (for normal profile)

- For any other custom files please save your old file and changes in order to not overwrite them, and then after the update copy/paste your custom changes to the new file. However, this is not something we would recommend, as you may inadvertently break new features/changes.
